Cesar Chavez led the civil rights movement with the intention of gaining better working conditions, living conditions, and better salaries for all farm workers. Cesar Chavez day is celebrated on March 31st in honor of Chavez's birthday. Throughout his life this man has greatly impacted the lives of not only farm workers but also of all people with a dream of a better tomorrow.
