3. Two page typed statement answering the following:
 - As president of a major university, you are preparing your first annual presidential address. This address must have three major strategic goals on recruitment and retention, specifically for students of color.
4. Write two pages on what Amendment 46 is. In addition, please include the following:
 - In the context of educational access is Amendment 46 needed, Why? Why not?
 - How many states have passed the Amendment 46? Name the states.
 - Why did Colorado not pass Amendment 46?
5. Scholarship recipients will be responsible for volunteering 20 hours each semester.
